
Dear Ms. Salas:

Representatives of Cablevision Lightpath discussed the above-captioned proceedings in telephone conversations on April 16 and 17. On April 16, Cablevision executives Sheila Mahony, Executive Vice President, Lisa Rosenblum, Senior Vice President, and Lee Schroeder, Vice President, Government and Regulatory Strategy, spoke with Commissioner Ness and her legal advisor, Jordan Goldstein. On April 17, James L. Dolan, Chief Executive Officer and President, spoke with Chairman Powell. Subsequently, the undersigned spoke with Chairman Powell's legal advisor, Kyle Dixon.

In each conversation, the Cablevision representatives reiterated the views which Cablevision Lightpath has already expressed on the public record in these proceedings regarding the proper compensation for traffic exchanged with incumbent local exchange carriers by full service facilities-based carriers.
