NOTICE OF DEPOSITION UPON ORAL EXAMINATION

1. The Enforcement Bureau, pursuant to section 1.315 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.315 hereby gives notice that it intends to take the deposition upon oral examination of Barbara James-Petersen. Ms. James-Petersen is currently the president of Family Broadcasting, Inc. ("Family") and is the general manager of stations WSTX(AM) and WSTX-FM ("the stations"). In addition, Ms. James-Petersen is proposed as one of four new shareholders (all of whom are siblings), who would acquire control of Family from their father and mother, Mr. Gerard Luz A. James and Ms. Asta K. James. At present, Mr. and Mrs. James control Family.

Ms. James-Petersen will be examined before a notary public or other person authorized to administer oaths on May 10, 2001, at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the Federal Communications Commission, 445 12th Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. Upon determination of the exact office location of the deposition, the Bureau will inform Family, Ms. James-Petersen and the presiding administrative law judge. Ms. James-


