American Homestar continues expansion through acquisition

American Homestar Corp. is manufacturing an acquisition plan that will enable it to become one of the leading mobile housing companies in the country.

League City-based American Homestar, which develops and sells manufactured homes, has signed a definitive agreement to purchase N.C. Mobile Home Corp. of North Carolina for as much as \$4.5 million. N.C. Mobile Home is a retailer with 12 locations, primarily in North Carolina.

The news comes on the heels of American Homestar's decision to purchase Alabama-based Brilliant Homes, which will add three new manufacturing plants to the company's network.

The Brilliant Homes and N.C. Mobile Home acquisitions are expected to close in June.

The N.C. Mobile Home purchase is contingent on certain performance targets and will be funded through \$2 million in American Homestar's common stock and \$2.5 million in cash.

American Homestar co-chief executive officer Finis F. Teeter says the company is attempting to strengthen its retail base through the N.C. Mobile Home purchase.

"This acquisition represents an important addition to our retail distribution network in the Carolinas," Teeter said in a prepared statement. "When added to our existing retail franchise system and the non-affiliated independent dealers we serve, these new company retail centers will afford us a broader and more solid distribution base from which we can continue to implement our vertical integration growth strategy."

American Homestar currently operates eight manufacturing plants and 52 company-owned retail centers. The firm serves more than 300 independent retail locations in 24 states.

When the Brilliant Homes and N.C. Mobile Home acquisitions are completed, American Homestar will operate 11 manufacturing plants serving more than 400 independent retailers and 67 company-owned retail centers.

American Homestar Corporation (Nasdaq/NM:HSTR) today announced results for the fourth quarter and fiscal year ended June 30, 2000. For the quarter, revenues were \$139 million compared with \$186 million in the year-earlier period. The net loss before special charges for the fourth quarter was \$3.2 million, or \$0.17 per diluted share, compared with net income of \$4.6 million, or \$0.25 per diluted share, in the prior-year period.

The Company previously announced that it would incur and provide for special charges relating to a restructuring of its retail operations and for the closing of its Henderson, North Carolina, manufacturing facility. Results for the fourth quarter reflect several restructuring, impairments and other special charges totaling \$27.4 million, after tax, or \$1.49 per diluted share. On an after-tax basis, the write-off of goodwill associated with prior retail acquisitions accounted for \$19.9 million of the total. Of this amount, \$9.8 million is goodwill associated with the acquisition of First Value Homes and NC Homes, which were not part of the Company's formal restructuring plan and were not included in previous estimates. Also on an after-tax basis, fixed asset impairment and other direct restructuring costs amounted to \$3.2 million, retail inventory impairments totaled \$2.6 million, and other items, principally an addition to the Company's warranty expense accrual, totaled \$1.7 million. As a result of these special charges, the Company posted a net loss of \$30.6 million, or \$1.66 per diluted share for the quarter.

For the year ended June 30, 2000, revenues were \$574 million compared with \$654 million in the comparable period last year. The net loss before special charges for fiscal 2000 was \$16.4 million, or \$0.89 per diluted share, compared with net income of \$17.9 million, or \$0.96 per diluted share, last year. Results for the year ended June 30 reflect the special charges mentioned above as well as after-tax charges of \$3.8 million, or \$0.20 per diluted share, in connection with the first and third quarter closings of the Company's manufacturing facilities in Vicksburg, Mississippi, and Brilliant, Alabama, asset impairment charges, and a provision for future losses in connection with new home repurchase, from retail dealers. Total after-tax special charges for the year ended June 30, 2000, were \$31.2 million, or \$1.69 per diluted share. Including special charges, the Company reported a net loss of \$47.6 million, or \$2.58 per diluted share, for the year ended June 30, 2000.

Commenting on fourth quarter results and the Company's future plans and outlook, President and Chief Executive Officer Laurence Dawson Jr. said, "Despite industry conditions, which have become increasingly challenging in the current quarter, we have made good progress implementing our Restructuring Plan. We had positive operating income before special charges in the quarter and had slightly positive operating cash flow. Our focus is to reduce costs and our breakeven volume in order to generate profitable operations on much lower revenue levels. As our plans are more fully implemented in the core operations and as the discontinued units are liquidated or phased out, we expect slow but steady progress in our operating results."

American Homestar is one of the leading vertically integrated manufactured housing companies. The Company currently operates 11 manufacturing plants, 109 Company-owned retail sales centers, 11 joint venture retail sales centers and serves 60 retail franchisees and over 300 independent retail locations in 28 states. The Company also provides retail financing through its new finance affiliate, Homestar 21, LLC, and provides insurance and transportation services to its customers.

American Homestar Corporation (Nasdaq/NM:HSTR) today announced plans to consolidate production in its Alabama manufacturing facilities. The plant in Brilliant, Alabama, will temporarily be idled, and production will be shifted to the Company's plant in Lynn, Alabama. The transition will be seamless for retailers, who will receive the same products and be served by the same sales team.

The Lynn facility, at 140,000 square feet, is the largest and has the greatest production capacity of the Company's three plants in Alabama. It will manufacture the product lines of both the Lynn and Brilliant plants until market demand is sufficient to utilize the capacity of both plants. Most Brilliant employees will be offered transfers to the Lynn plant, which is located a short commuting distance away. The Company also operates a plant in Guin, Alabama, which is currently operating at solid production rates and will remain open.

Commenting on the plant consolidation, Chief Executive Officer Laurence Dawson, Jr. said, "We have seen some encouraging signs in this region during the last several weeks. Order input and production rates have been gradually improving, but have not yet reached levels that support all three Alabama plants at desired levels. This consolidation will allow us to improve capacity utilization rates at both Guin and our recently modernized Lynn facility. It is part of our plan to aggressively improve the performance of all of our operating units. Our goal is to ensure that all business units are profitable by the end of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000."

The Company indicated that it will incur one-time charges in the third quarter ending March 31, 2000, to recognize certain restructuring expenses and other non-cash reserves in connection with the consolidation. Specific amounts of such charges are not yet available.
