Dear Secretary Salas:

Pursuant to Section 1.206 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, 47 C.F.R., §1.206 (b), ArrayComm hereby provides two copies of a Notice of such communication.

On April 20, 2001, Marc Goldberg, Chief Technical Officer of ArrayComm and the undersigned met with representatives of the Commission's Public Safety and Private Wireless Division of the Commission's Wireless Bureau regarding the above referenced Docket. Attending for the Division were: John Borkowski, Zenji Nakazawa, Brian O-Donnell and Tim Maguire. Roberto Mussenden participated via telephone.

ArrayComm reviewed its i-BURST system and described the advantages that a system which combines TDD and smart antennas would provide in terms of increased spectrum efficiency. ArrayComm also reviewed its Comments and Replies in this Docket, particularly its efforts to coordinate with adjacent and co-channel US Government facilities.

We asked about auction schedules and about the prospects for a nation-wide auction of the entire 5 MHz since the only three parties on record as having an interest in 1670-1675 MHz all favor such an auction.
