Pursuant to Section 1-206 (b) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, C.F.R. § 1.206 (b), two copies of this Notice are included herein.


On May 2, 2001, Bradley Holmes and Leonard Kolsky representing ArrayComm, Inc. met with Peter Tenhula., assistant to Chairman Michael Powell, regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

We reviewed the major points presented by ArrayComm, Inc. in its comments and reply comments. We stressed the desirability of a nation-wide auction, pointing out that the other parties who had expressed interest in 1670-1675 MHz also favored such an auction.

We also asked for an early auction date on the basis that disposition of this band was not apt to be controversial.

Mr. Tenhula reminded us that any allocation for TDD would occur in the second rule-making phase. The first would probably only designate the band as available for fixed and mobile usage.
