Dear Secretary Salas:

On May 4, 2001, Martin Cooper, Bradley Holmes and I, representing ArrayComm, Inc. ("ArrayComm"), met with Commissioner Gloria Tristani and Adam Krinsky regarding the above-titled matter.

ArrayComm reviewed the key points in its filing, emphasizing the spectrum efficiency benefits of TDD and i-BURST. We also printed out the suitability of 1670-1675 MHz and the work done with the adjacent channel US Government systems to effect satisfactory coordination procedures.

Since the other two parties which had expressed interest in this band had also advocated a nation-wide auction, ArrayComm expressed the hope that the Commission would act accordingly.


Finally, ArrayComm asked for the auction to be held as early as possible. Because of the limited interest in the band, ArrayComm believes that an expedited auction would engender no controversy.
