On May 16, 2001, Ward L. Quaal of HBI and Andrew Paul of the SBCA met with Bruce A. Franca, Deputy Chief, OET, Thomas Derenge, Chief, Spectrum Policy Branch, OET, and Geraldine Matise, Deputy Chief, Policy & Rules Branch, OET to discuss the MITRE Report. On May 17, 2001, Ward L.
