On May 18, 2001, Mr. John Lyons of Motorola and I held an *ex parte* meeting with the staff of the Public Safety and Private Wireless Division to discuss the impact of the Multi-Use Radio Service (MURS) on incumbent business and industrial two-way radio users. Please associate this notice in the docket file of WT Docket No. 98-182.

Mr. Lyons and I repeated Motorola's concern expressed throughout this proceeding that increased consumer uses of the MURS frequencies would result in new interference risks to business and industrial users of these frequencies. We therefore urged the staff to grant Motorola's *Petition for Reconsideration* or otherwise ensure that the level of service afforded to business and industrial users is not diminished.
