This is in response to the request for verification of the correctness of the Fiscal Year (FY) 1999 regulatory fee payment filed on behalf of Thomas B. Daniels, holder of the construction permit for FM radio station WJNI.


Dear Mr. Fishel:

Thomas B. Daniels, by his attorney, hereby notifies the Commission that it is filing an Annual Regulatory Fee in the amount of \$780 in lieu of the \$1400 specified in the *Public Notice* "FY 1999 Mass Media Regulatory Fees."
