WKYT Licensee Corporation respectfully requests a further extension of time to file its Form 301 in response to the Report and Order issued in the above-captioned proceeding.


By letter of May 16, 2001, the licensee advised the Commission that it was necessary to request a 30-day extension to June 18, 2001 to file its Form 301 because the licensee had experienced significant delays in obtaining the proper specifications from its antenna manufacturer.

The licensee and its consulting engineer felt that the matter would be determined by this time. Additional negotiations, however, continue between the consulting engineer and the antenna manufacturer in an effort to quickly resolve this problem.
