Dear Secretary Salas:

On June 8, 2001, ArrayComm, Inc. (hereinafter ArrayComm), through its representatives, Randall Coleman, Brett Tarnutzer and Leonard Kolsky, met with members of the Wireless Bureau of the Commission, namely Kathleen Ham, Dwana Terry and Jamison Prime.

ArrayComm asked several general questions about auction schedules and specific questions about 1670-1675 MHz. We were told that this band along with the other spectrum in Docket No. 00-221 is on a "fast track" with an auction likely to occur early in 2002.

ArrayComm also explained its reasons for seeking a nation-wide auction and pointed out that the only other two known contestants for this spectrum, AeroAstro and MicroTrax, favored such an approach.

Finally, Ms. Terry explained the possible ways that an entity such as ArrayComm might be regulated.
