**COMMENTS OF
Northern California Region VI Review and Revision Committee**

INTRODUCTION

This Regional Plan was adopted by the Commission November 29, 1990. It has been necessary to modify the Plan three times in the ensuing years to change the channel assignments and other minor adjustments. The enclosed Request for Modification is for the same purpose.

COMMENTS

All channels in the San Francisco Bay area are heavily used. Demand continues to increase, and the existing allotments and assignments must be adjusted to attempt to meet the demand. Minor changes to the text of the Plan that will facilitate the function and administration of the Plan are made at the same time. This Request is made for the same purposes

Notice of the intent to modify the Plan were publicized through available means and all agencies that had requested additional channels were notified. Sixty days were provided for additional request and a public meeting of the Review and Revision Committee was held on April 24, 2001. (Minutes of the meeting are attached).

Representatives of all agencies submitting requests were in attendance. Although

Representatives of all agencies submitting requests were in attendance. Although there were insufficient available channels to meet all expressed needs there was a harmonious agreement to make adjustments and an offer by two of the agencies to pursue a consolidated system. The resultant decision of the attendees was presented to the Committee and after due deliberation, a new table of allotments and allocations was adopted. (Attachment G enclosed)

A minor modification to delineate the duties of the officers was discussed and approved by the Committee (Attached)

Copies of the revised Attachment G were sent to the adjoining regions in Nevada, Southern California and Oregon. Approval was given by all. (Attached)

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Review and Revision Committee recommends the modifications as shown in Attachment D and the modification to change Section 11.4 of the Regional Plan be approved by the Commission.


CONCLUSION

The Secretary shall take minutes of the meetings and make them available to the members of the Committee and to others on request. The Secretary shall also assist as required in the duties listed above.





EXECUTIVE SUMMARY MINUTES

Dublin, Ca
April 24, 2001

Chairperson McDole opened the special meeting of the NPSPAC Review and Revision Committee for Region Six at 1000 hours. A roll call of committee members was taken:

Those Present: Chair Art Mc Dole, Ron Allison, Terry Betts, Jim Coats, Harry Engstrom, Tom Herold, Ron Kiesel, Ken Mitchell, Don Root and Ken Steuber.

Those Absent: Vice-Chair Glen Nash, Dianne Beaumont, Heinz Klose, John Schmidt (and unfilled Police-City).

Business Items

1. Chair McDole opened the meeting by introducing himself noting that there were many new faces present at this meeting. He further indicated that this meeting had been publicized for the expressed purpose of reviewing the current Region 6 NPAPAC Plan. In this process, a window of opportunity had been opened soliciting requests from public-safety agencies in the Region 6 area to put forward requests for additional frequency allocations within this plan. He then summarized the requests received during the window opening, noting that it had closed on April 1, 2001.
2. Self-introductions were suggested and accomplished. Chair McDole acknowledged a large contingent representing the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Department was present. He further acknowledged that he was pleased to finally associate names and faces of individuals within the Sheriff's Department with whom he had been corresponding.
3. Chair McDole then circulated copies of the current frequency allocation tables as the basis for today's discussions.
 - a. Livermore-Amador Valley Transit Agency's request was addressed as presenting the least complex issues. Channel 777 was proposed. A close examination identified co-channel users and adjacent channel users. Those operating on the adjacent channels were present at the meeting and indicated that no technical issues were presented. By show of hands, the proposal received unanimous approval.
 - b. Bay Area Rapid Transit District's proposal to move the City of Palo Alto from 770 to 678 was heard. Palo Alto was present and agreed to the channel shift. BARTD would then take 771 and vacate 737. Item was approved by a voice vote.
 - c. Stanislaus County's request was next undertaken. Chair McDole identified the following channels: 613, 617, 624, 628, 642, 650, 668, 673, 692, 702, 729, 742, 759, 787, 807 and 811. A unanimous verbal approval by the Committee for up to 16 channels to be allocated to Stanislaus County for future needs was given to the proposal.
 - d. Contra Costa County. As a preface to this discussion, Chair McDole indicated that there were insufficient numbers of channels to satisfy both Contra Costa County and Richmond. A minimum of two channels for

Richmond and three channels for Contra Costa are requested. Both agencies have been advised that the General Pool channels in the 800 MHz band also may be considered. Chair McDole circulated a chart he had prepared showing his recommendations to the Committee. These were discussed.

It was pointed out that in the Contra Costa recommendations that 692 was also recommended for Stanislaus County (action above), and that 691 and 693 would also then be contiguous in the same system. Contra Costa indicated that this would be acceptable to them as uses could be geographically separated, or that an opportunity might be afforded for wide-band data under Commission waivers.

- e. **Richmond:** Richmond has requested channels 737 and 743. The Committee deliberated this request. Chair McDole indicated that there was no way that five channels at Nichol Knob could be accommodated in the Plan.

Richmond again was encouraged to examine the GP and General Pool spectrum to determine if there was any way that this might become a solution to the issue. Richmond pointed out that they had a working system that was becoming critical and needed immediate consideration for expansion and pressed for approval of 737 and 743.

Today Richmond is operating 1,200 units on five channels and have somewhat reached a critical situation: additional channels are needed for immediate expansion relief.

4. The meeting then was recessed until 1330 hours.
5. The meeting was called back to order at 1318 hours with all Committee members from the morning session present.
6. Chair McDole asked for a clarification from Contra Costa: Did they have a funding source in hand for their proposal? Contra Costa responded that they were caught in a dichotomy: their management would not commit to funding until frequencies were assured, the Committee would not proceed until a funding commitment was obtained. It was then announced that Richmond and Contra Costa were able to meet during the noon-hour and had come to a possible resolve of their issues. That being that they would co-license on 737 and 743 at Nichol Knob. This would allow the Richmond system to proceed as quickly as possible and Contra Costa would later join this system.

Moved by Root, Seconded by Betts, to allocate 737 and 743 to Richmond and allot the following channels to Contra Costa County: 602, 618, 620, 628, 642, 650, 665, 674, 680, 689, 691, 693, 702, 709, 711, 731, 737, 743, 744, 756, 761, 784, 795, 821, 824 and 827. The above is in addition to any existing Contra Costa allotments. The proposal received unanimous vote by show of hands by the Committee members.

7. Having settled the technical issues of the day, Chair McDole acknowledged the services of Preston Thomson as Secretary Pro-Tem for the past five plus years. He also pointed out that in first preparing the Region 6 Plan, there had been no provision for a Secretary. Chair McDole proposed, seconded by Root, that the voting position of Secretary be incorporated in the next Plan revision. A voice vote of the Committee was unanimous.
8. Moved by Betts, Seconded by Root, to authorize the Chair to review the text portions of the Plan and make such changes as found necessary. By voice vote, motion past unanimously.

Adjourned:

Having concluded the business at hand, the meeting was adjourned at 1355 hours. The next Review and Revision Committee meeting will be held in Napa County, on June 7, 2001 (Thursday) at the conclusion of the Northern Chapter of APCO's monthly Frequency and Engineering meeting (approximately 2 PM).
