By the Accounting Policy Division:

On May 8, 2001, the Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, FCC 01-145, in the above-captioned dockets.¹ This Erratum corrects the following non-substantive error in the released text of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking:
