Dear Ms. Salas:

This letter corrects and clarifies the chart of programming interests attached to AT&T's *ex parte* submission to you dated June 8, 2001 in the above-captioned proceeding. First, the Sunshine Network, a regional programming network, was inadvertently omitted from the list of AT&T programming interests. Although AT&T has initiated steps to dispose of its interest in the Sunshine Network, AT&T currently retains that interest, and the Sunshine Network should have been listed.

Second, as noted on the chart, the source of the AT&T, Time Warner and Cablevision programming interests information was Appendix D-5 of the Commission's latest Video Competition Report.¹ That appendix does not list Music Choice, which provides digital audio programming. Thus, although Appendix B to the AT&T-MediaOne Merger Order lists Music Choice as a "MediaOne Video Programming Interest," it was not included in the June 8th chart.²


