Dear Ms. Salas:

I am writing to inform you that we will be filing with the staff today three replacement copies of CDs 1 and 2 from Verizon's proprietary cost study filing on July 2. After the initial cost study filing was completed, Verizon learned that these CDs each inadvertently contained an older version of one of the files. The paper version of the studies also filed on July 2 did *not* contain these errors. Because the studies are proprietary, we are not filing copies of the CDs with the Secretary's office.

The errors themselves had no substantive impact on the cost studies themselves, but involve only an index and a summary file. In particular, the changes reflected on the corrected CDs are the following:

1. **CD No. 1, Labeled: VZ-VA FCC ARB, Loop Cost Analysis Model**
  - CD INDEX - VAFCCARB\_CDINDEX.doc file, dated 6/15/01, 2:44 p.m.: This file is simply the CD Index that contains the list of electronic files and associated cost studies and workpapers provided on July 2, 2001. An incorrect version of the file was inadvertently included on the original CD No. 1. The correct and revised file has been replaced on CD 1 and is named VAFCCARB\_CDINDEX.doc, dated 7/6/01, 2:24 p.m.



2 **CD No. 2, Labeled: VZ-VA FCCARB, Additional Cost Studies**

- Non-Recurring Rate Summary (Exhibit H, Section 1) -VA\_2001\_UNE\_Rate Summary.xls file, originally dated 6/28/01 – 12:30 p.m.: An older version of this summary file was inadvertently included on the electronic copy of CD No. 2. The correct version of the file has been replaced on CD No. 2 and renamed VA\_2001\_UNE\_Rate Summary.xls, dated 6/29/01 – 1:29 p.m. This file can be found in the folder labeled: VA EXCEL & WORD STUDIES, Subfolder: VA NON-RECURRING STUDY. The specific revisions were made to VA\_UNE\_Rate\_Summary (Tab 2) – Line 768, IDLC Port cost; VA\_UNE\_Rate\_Summary (Tab 2) – Line 787 – Reciprocal Compensation elements and final costs; Copy Recurring Summary (Tab 3) – Line 113, IDLC Port; and Copy Recurring Summary (Tab 3) – Lines 178-182, Reciprocal Compensation. The numbering system for the Part Numbers also reflects updates.


