On July 10, 2001, George Marble, Vice President, Marketing, Grayson Wireless Division ("Grayson") of Allen Telecom, Inc. ("Allen") and I had an *ex parte* meeting with Adam Krinsky, legal advisor to Commissioner Gloria Tristani. We discussed carrier field trials and other carrier testing of Grayson's Geometrix® Wireless Location System. We discussed the system configurations tested, the conditions under which the trials and tests have been conducted, and the performance of the Geometrix systems in the testing. We also reviewed that the Geometrix system is now in production and generally available to carriers to implement in connection with satisfying the Commission's E-911 Phase II caller location mandate.
