On behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. ("ATTWS"), Doug Brandon, Scott Blake Harris, and undersigned counsel met on July 13, 2001 with Tom Sugrue, Ron Netro, and Joel Taubenblatt of the Commission's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau with regard to the above referenced proceeding. At that meeting, ATTWS discussed its concerns about potential blanketing interference from high power SDARS repeaters into its WCS networks as reflected in its filings in this proceeding, as well as potential options for resolving those concerns by imposing power and other limitations. ATTWS expressed its desire to continue to explore such options.
