

Second Quarterly Report

Dear Ms. Salas:

This report is filed pursuant to the directive contained in the Commission's Fourth Report and Order (CC Docket No. 94-102), FCC 00-436, released December 14, 2000 ("the Fourth R&O").

Uintah Basin Electronic Telecommunications d/b/a UBET Wireless is the licensee of the referenced Frequency Block E stations in the Broadband Personal Communications Service. The licensed facilities have not been constructed and placed into commercial service, and our first buildout showing is not due to be filed until April 28, 2002 in the case of Station KNLG530, and June 26, 2002 in the case of Stations WPQZ730 and WPQZ731.

Reading together the Fourth R&O and Sections 20.18(a) and (c) of the Commission's Rules, it appears that the quarterly report filing requirement applies only to digital wireless systems that are already in operation, by stating that these requirements are applicable only to "service providers" and "carriers operating digital wireless systems." Since we are not yet providing commercial service over the referenced systems, it appears that we are not required to file this report. Accordingly, we are filing this report to preclude any inquiry from the Commission that might otherwise be forthcoming.

We wish to assure the Commission, nevertheless, that we will comply with the requirements of Section 20.18 of the Commission's Rules once our licensed facilities have been constructed and are

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providing commercial service, and once the necessary equipment becomes commercially available.
