On July 13, 2001, Lon Levin of XM Radio Inc. ("XM Radio"), along with XM Radio's counsel, Bruce Jacobs and David Konczal of Shaw Pittman, met with Adam Krinsky, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Tristani, to discuss XM Radio's Digital Audio Radio Service ("DARS") system as well as the use of terrestrial repeaters. XM Radio discussed possible options for addressing the concerns of WCS licensees regarding the operation of high power repeaters, including the principles involved in the repeater rules that XM has proposed.
