
Dear Ms. Salas:

On Thursday, July 19, 2001, Michael Amarosa and Joe Sheehan of TruePosition, Inc. ("TruePosition") and Philip Verveer and I, of Willkie Farr & Gallagher met with Thomas Sugrue, Chief of the Bureau, and James Schlichting, Blaise Scinto and Joel Taubenblatt of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

At this meeting, we discussed AT&T Wireless Services, Inc.'s and Cingular Wireless LLC's pending waiver requests, and the potential impact of these waiver requests on the deployment of E911.
