PSAP REQUEST FOR PHASE II SERVICES WITH CERTIFICATION OF READINESS

Dear Sirs:

Pursuant to the FCC CC Docket 94-102 Report & Order and subsequent orders on Wireless Enhanced 9-1-1 Service, (9-1-1 District/PSAP) requests that your company provide Phase II Services to our jurisdiction.

911 District/PSAP understands that the FCC requires that it be capable of receiving and utilizing Phase II information prior to requesting this service. To that end this letter states that we are capable of using that information in responding to emergency service requests from a mobile phone. In particular, we report that our Automatic Location Identification (ALI), whether provided by our 9-1-1 ALI services provider or self-provisioned,¹ is capable of the TR-45 “Enhanced Wireless 9-1-1 Phase 2” J-STD-036 E2 interface including the ability to receive and forward the confidence level to us. We further state that our CPE equipment has been upgraded to use information delivered in the J-STD-036 format. Finally, we are prepared to provide the data necessary for Phase II deployment, including boundary maps and routing information, and to cooperate in the installation and testing of these systems. We understand that these issues are critical to Phase II deployment and that the E2 interface and confidence level are required by the industry standard (J-STD-036). We intend to implement our Phase II Service to meet that standard and expect the wireless carrier to also meet that standard. Furthermore, if there are any changes that may alter our abilities to receive and utilize the E911 data we will notify you immediately.

[If the PSAP is not able to use the Phase II information, then the above paragraph must state what contract the PSAP has entered into that will provide this capability prior to the date of the wireless carrier’s obligation to begin delivering the Phase II Service.]

[If the PSAP’s ALI vendor cannot provide the E2 interface, then the PSAP must explain how it intends to handle the interface until it has developed its standard to the J-Std-036 E2 de facto interface and provide ALI vendor contact information.]
