

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Jeraldine Anderson respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 299A at Benjamin, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 299A to Benjamin, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Benjamin is an incorporated city with a population of 230 people and is the county seat of Knox County. Benjamin has its own mayor, Mike Scheedy, its own volunteer fire department, its own post office, its own school district and a number of local churches.


