On July 27, 2001, Dennis Kahan, Chief Executive Officer of SigmaOne Communications Corporation (“SigmaOne”), Sandy Mayer, Vice President of Corporate Development and Technology for SigmaOne, Michael Alpert, member of the Board of Directors of SigmaOne and the undersigned met with Jordan Goldstein, Sam Feder, Bryan Tramont, Cathy Hilke, Adam Krinsky, Thomas Sugrue, Blaise Scinto, Kris Monteith, Martin Liebman, Patrick Forster and Joel Taubenblatt regarding the above-captioned proceeding.

The following subjects were discussed: SigmaOne’s and True Position’s ex parte filings; that no company attempting to meet the FCC’s location standards used MNLS because it does not work; the AT&T waiver request pending before the Commission; the fact that the test data supporting the waiver request is unaudited; the fact that the MNLS database used for the test was generated using measured data only (versus using data from propagation tools); the fact that the tests were not done in real time or in a real world environment; that MNLS deployment timelines has little vendor or network infrastructure support; that AT&T will not transition to GSM for a very long time due to the large number of TDMA and AMPS customers AT&T has; that the waiver should be denied and if it were denied what alternatives might exist to accelerate deployment of E-911; that SigmaOne conducted three audited trials with Cingular (Suburban, Urban, Rural) including a Suburban test SigmaOne conducted with SBC prior to the formation of Cingular; the ability of the SigmaOne system to support GSM (E-OTD) together with TDMA via a relatively inexpensive software download.

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
