

PICS/DCPR COLUMN DESCRIPTIONS

1. Geo Region – designates the geographic region (North or South) to which the record applies
2. State – the state/jurisdiction in which the equipment has been placed
3. Account Area – another designation for the state in which the equipment is being installed
4. Engineering Area – a code designating the specific engineering area within the state in which the equipment is being installed
5. SBU -
6. CLLI – the Common Language Location Identifier code which identifies the specific central office location where the equipment is placed
7. Acct Loc/Serial – a geographic location code used to identify each building or location for which accounting has recorded investment
8. CPR – the 6 digit number used to identify either equipment or a specific type of investment in DCPR.
9. FRC – the standard field reporting code used to designate the subaccount within the Part 32 main account to which the equipment is booked
10. ECN – a 3 to 5 character code used to classify equipment by type and usage as follows:
 - 000 to 099 = Miscellaneous
 - 100 to 199 = Manual Switching
 - 200 to 299 = Dial Tandem Switching
 - 300 to 399 = Intertoll Dial Equipment
 - 400 to 499 = Automatic Message Accounting
 - 500 to 599 = Other Toll Switching
 - 600 to 699 = Local Dial Switching
 - 700 to 799 = Special service Equipment
 - 800 to 899 = Circuit Equipment
 - 900 to 998 = Power Equipment
 - 999 = Minor Capitalized Items
11. Basic Unit -
12. CPR Description – the abbreviated English description of the type of equipment
13. MFGR Part No. – the manufacturers part number for the equipment being installed
14. Equipment Quantity – how many of the particular item were installed
15. Year in place – the year the item was classified as plant ready for service
16. Frame ID – the code that designates the location of an associated frame – both the floor and the specific frame location
17. Material cost – the original purchase price excluding taxes
18. In Place Cost – for plug-ins this equals the material cost plus sales and use taxes, for hard wired equipment it equals the material cost plus a prorated portion of the installation labor charges, engineering
19. Floor Designation – the Central Office floor on which the equipment was installed – same as first part of frame ID
20. Frame Designation – the specific location of the associated frame – same as second part of frame ID
21. Database date – the date the record was last modified in the database
22. Database ID – designates whether the item is a hardwired (h) or plug in (P) item
23. Txtcurrdate – the date the data was pulled from DCPR
24. Material Cost – same as number 17 above
25. In place Cost – same as number 18 above
