Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, an original and three copies of this letter are being filed as notice that representatives of The Walt Disney Company (Disney) attended a meeting on August 8, 2001, with Commissioner Kevin Martin and David Brown. Representing Disney were Preston Padden, Executive Vice President, and myself.

The proceedings at issue are not restricted and therefore presentations are permitted, but must be disclosed. With respect to DA 01-1264, during the meeting, Disney simply referred the Commissioner and Mr. Brown to the comments recently filed by Disney, and left a copy of Disney's comments for the Commissioner and Mr. Brown. A copy of Disney's comments are attached to this notice. With respect to CS Docket 98-120, Disney noted that the allegations contained in the comments filed by the American Cable Association are without merit because ABC offers cable operators a stand-alone price for retransmission of the ABC owned and operated stations.
