PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 256A at **Harbor Beach**, Michigan.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 256A to **Harbor Beach**, Michigan, as that community's first competing FM service. The FCC data base currently shows 279C2 licensed to Harbor Beach, Michigan. **Harbor Beach** is an incorporated city with a population in excess of 1,800 people. **Harbor Beach** has its own mayor, Ed Ramsey, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department, its own city hall and a number of local churches.
