PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Charles Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 246A at **Roscommon**, Michigan.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 246A to **Roscommon**, Michigan, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. **Roscommon** is a township with a population in excess of 1,000 people. **Roscommon** has its own village manager, Mike Freer, its own school system, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department, its own township hall and a number of local churches.


