**SUPPLEMENT**

Marathon Media Group, L.L.C. ("Marathon"), licensee of Station KONY-FM, Kanab, Utah, by its counsel, respectfully submits this supplement to its counterproposal filed on August 13, 2001 in the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>1</sup> The purpose of this supplement is to correct a statement in the counterproposal regarding the preferential arrangement of allotments under the Commission's priorities.

Marathon proposed that Channel 265C be allotted to Moapa, Nevada and Channel 266C be deleted at Kanab, Utah. To avoid loss of Kanab's only local service, a new allotment of 270C2 was proposed. Therefore, the proper comparison is between a first local service at Moapa together with a new allotment at Kanab (priority 3) or retaining KONY at Kanab with no new service at Moapa.<sup>2</sup> Clearly, having both communities with local service is a preferential arrangement of allotments. *See,*

The counterproposal, as filed, incorrectly made reference to St. George, Utah at the end of paragraph 7 on the top of page 4. Marathon respectfully requests that the Commission substitute this supplement for the incorrect portion of that paragraph.
