Pursuant to section 1.46(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 47 C.F.R. §1.46(b), the Illinois Commerce Commission ("ICC") hereby respectfully requests that the Commission accept the Comments of the Illinois Commerce Commission for filing *instanter* in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, the ICC states as follows:

1. The Commission released a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking' in the above-caption proceeding on April 27, 2001; and August 21, 2001, was established as the date for interested parties to file initial comments thereon.

2. The ICC intended and was prepared to file its Comments in response to the Commission's NPRM on August 21, 2001, utilizing the Commission's electronic filing system.

3. The ICC had no knowledge that the Commission's electronic filing system requires the use of Netscape Explorer version 4.7.

4. The ICC does not own or otherwise have access to Netscape Explorer version 4.7 to utilize to file its Comments via the Commission's electronic filing system.

5. Upon the ICC's discovery that Netscape Explorer version 4.7 is required to utilize the Commission's electronic filing system, the ICC acted diligently by sending the original and




