**MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER**  
(Proceeding Terminated)

Adopted: August 13, 2001

By the Commission:

1. The Commission has before it an Application for Review filed by Conner Media Corporation ("Connor Media"), licensee of Station WBSY, Channel 224A, Rose Hill, North Carolina, directed to the staff Memorandum Opinion and Order in this proceeding. 15 FCC Rcd 10739 (2000). Woolstone Corporation, permittee of Station WFPF, Channel 283A, Aurora, North Carolina, filed an Opposition to Application for Review and Connor Media filed a Reply to Opposition to Application for Review. In addition, Woolstone Corporation filed a Motion to Strike, Connor Media filed an Opposition to Motion to Strike, and Woolstone Corporation filed a Reply to Opposition to Motion to Strike. We have thoroughly reviewed the staff decision and find that there are no errors of law or new facts that would warrant reversing the staff action. Accordingly, we deny the Application for Review.

2. In addition to the matters at issue in the Application for Review, Woolstone Corporation filed a Motion to Strike. That Motion is directed to the Connor Media Reply to Opposition to Application for Review in which Connor Media submitted information concerning the availability of a transmitter site for a Channel 221A allotment at Aurora, North Carolina. Woolstone Corporation contends that this should be stricken because the staff has had no opportunity to consider this information and a Reply is limited to matters raised in an Opposition to Application for Review. In view of our action denying the underlying Application for Review filed by Connor Media and the fact that the availability of a transmitter site is no longer an issue in this proceeding, we dismiss the Motion to Strike.

3. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, That the aforementioned Application for Review filed by Connor Media Corporation IS DENIED.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the aforementioned Motion to Strike filed by Woolstone Corporation IS DISMISSED.

5. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That this proceeding IS TERMINATED.
