On yesterday afternoon, Robert Quinn and I (both of AT&T) along with Peter Kiesler of Sidley, Austin, Brown & Wood met with Monica Desai, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Kevin Martin. We discussed AT&T's views on Verizon's Section 271 application for authority to provide in-region, interLATA services in Pennsylvania, as previously advanced in this proceeding.

During this meeting, we discussed the following matters: (1) the inadequacies of the current Performance Assurance Plan, (2) concerns about the viability and accuracy of Verizon's electronic billing systems, (3) the fact that Verizon's UNE rates are not TELRIC-compliant, and (4) Verizon's DSL resale obligations.
