Southwest FM Broadcasting Co., Inc. ("Southwest FM"), licensee of Station KAHM(FM), Prescott, Arizona, by its counsel, hereby submits these Comments in response to the Commission's Notice of Proposed Rule Making ("NPRM") in the above-referenced proceeding (released July 13, 2001).

The NPRM seeks comment on a proposal to add Channel 263C3 to the community of Paulden, Arizona, as its first local aural station. Southwest FM hereby states for the record that supports the proposal to add Channel 263C3 to the community of Paulden, Arizona. Furthermore, in the event the Commission makes said allocation, Southwest FM will prepare and file an application for the allocation and, if its application is granted by the Commission (whether after an auction or otherwise), it will proceed with the construction of the station in accordance with the
