

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 232A at **Hebbronville**, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 232A to **Hebbronville**, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. The FCC data base currently shows KEKO, channel 269A at **Hebbronville**. **Hebbronville** is a community with a population in excess of 4,000 people. **Hebbronville** has its own city commissioner, Oscar Gonzalez, its own school system, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department and a number of local churches.


