
Dear Ms. Anderson:

This is in response to the Petition for Rule Making you filed requesting the allotment of Channel 245C3 at Sonora, Texas. We have reviewed the proposal and find that it is unacceptable for rule making at this time.

A staff engineering analysis indicates that the above-requested allotment can not be made in compliance with the Commission's spacing requirements. The allotment of Channel 245C3 at Sonora at your proposed site, 30-26-58 and 100-39-59, is short spaced to Channel 245C1 at San Antonio, Texas. On October 10, 2000, First Broadcasting Company L.P. et al. filed a counterproposal in MM Docket No. 00-148 requesting the substitution of Channel 245C1 for Channel 247C and modification of the license for Station KAJA accordingly. See 15 FCC Red 15809 (2000).

Based on the above discussion, we are returning your petition for rule making. Alternatively, you may wish to determine if another channel is available for allotment at Sonora that does not conflict with the counterproposal filed in MM Docket No. 00-148.

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Jeraldine Anderson respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 245C3 at Sonora, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 245C3 to Sonora, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. Sonora is an incorporated city and the county seat of Sutton County. Sonora has a population of 2,983 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. As of March 1999, 229 business establishments in Sonora had been given a credit rating by Dun & Bradstreet. Sonora has its own mayor, Max E. Hooten, its own fire department, its own post office, its own school district and a number of local churches.

The information provided in this Petition for Rule Making is correct and true to the best of my knowledge.


