Dear Ms. Salas:

On September 7, 2001, Shirley Fujimoto, Kirk Burgee and Paul Malmud of McDermott, Will & Emery, and Mark Dobbs, Bob Stout and Ed Cunningham of Cinergy Corporation met with Monica Desai of the Federal Communications Commission to discuss the above-referenced proceeding. The discussion related to matters raised by Cinergy in its Petition for Reconsideration that was filed in this docket. Specifically, they discussed: (1) how Cinergy utilizes spectrum to perform a variety of tasks; (2) why Cinergy cannot use alternatives to spectrum to perform these tasks; (3) why overlay auctions are detrimental to incumbent utility operations; and (4) why the Commission should reconsider its decision that spectrum allocated to the utilities can be auctioned.
