On behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. ("AWS"), Doug Brandon, Bill Wiltshire, and undersigned counsel met on September 5, 2001 with Bryan Tramont, legal adviser to Commissioner Abernathy, with regard to the above referenced proceedings. During the meeting, we discussed AWS' continuing concerns about potential blanketing interference from high power SDARS repeaters into its WCS networks as reflected in its filings in these proceedings, as well as potential options for resolving those concerns both in the short term (with respect to the STAs) and in the longer term (with respect to the proposed rules).
