On behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. ("AWS"), Doug Brandon, Scott Blake Harris, and undersigned counsel met on September 7, 2001 with Paul Margie, legal adviser to Commissioner Copps, with regard to the above referenced proceedings. During the meeting, we discussed AWS' continuing concerns about potential blanketing interference from high power SDARS repeaters into its WCS networks as reflected in its filings in these proceedings, as well as potential options for resolving those concerns both in the short term (with respect to the STAs) and in the longer term (with respect to the proposed rules). We also discussed issues related to AWS' equipment design and its ability to tolerate signals from high power repeaters.
