

On behalf of AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. ("AWS"), Doug Brandon and undersigned counsel met on September 6, 2001 with Peter Tenhula, senior legal advisor to Chairman Powell, with regard to the above referenced proceedings. During the meeting, AWS discussed its continuing concerns about potential blanketing interference from high power SDARS repeaters into its WCS networks as reflected in its filings in these proceedings as well as potential options for resolving those concerns both in the short term (with respect to the STAs) and in the longer term (with respect to the proposed rules).
