

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 287A at Premont, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 287A to Premont, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM station. Premont is an incorporated city with a population in excess of 2,800 people. Premont has its own mayor, Norma Tullos, its own school system, its own post office, its own volunteer fire department, its own city hall and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 287A to Premont will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Premont residents and therefore is in the public interest.




