PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 237C3 at Sonora, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 237C3 to Sonora, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. Sonora is an incorporated city with a population in excess of 2,980 people. Sonora has its own mayor, Max E. Hooten, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department and a number of local churches. The proposed channel 237C3 to Sonora will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local self-expression to Sonora residents and therefore is in the public interest.


