
Dear Ms. Salas:

On Monday, September 10, 2001, Michael Amarosa, Philip Verveer, and I, on behalf of TruePosition, Inc. ("TruePosition"), met with Thomas Sugrue, Chief of the Bureau, James Schlichtling, Kris Monteith and Joel Taubenblatt of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

At this meeting, we discussed the agreement recently reached between Cingular Wireless and TruePosition to deploy TruePosition's network-based solution in 2,000 cell sites by December 31, 2002. We also discussed the forthcoming E911 Senate hearing as well as the pending requests for waiver of the Commission's E911 requirements.
