PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Jeraldine Anderson respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 296A at Bellmead, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 296A to Bellmead, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Bellmead is an incorporated city with a population of 8,403 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Bellmead has its own mayor, Robert Hawkins, its own fire department, its own post office, its own school system, its own City Hall and a number of local churches.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 296A can be allocated to Bellmead, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992). Note: According to Report & Order MM Docket No. 98-198 released March 21, 2000, KDXT channel 294C at Granbury, Texas has moved to channel 296C1 at Benbrook, Texas and KWBU channel 296A at Waco, Texas has been moved to channel 277A at Waco, Texas.






