On Tuesday September 25, 2001, Jim Casserly and I, representing AT&T, had a meeting with Matthew Brill, Commissioner Abernathy's Legal Adviser, to discuss matters which touched, indirectly, on some the issues raised in the aforementioned proceeding. Specifically, we explained to Mr. Brill how AT&T provisions services to its end user customers utilizing ILEC special access facilities and how the application of use restrictions by the ILECs, among other things, prevents AT&T from obtaining those underlying facilities as UNEs. The positions expressed by AT&T were consistent with those contained in the Comments and ex parte filings previously made in this docket.
