

Dear Ms. Salas:

On September 26, 2001, representatives of XM Radio Inc. ("XM") met with Commission staff to discuss the supplement XM filed on September 24<sup>th</sup> to its August 29<sup>th</sup> White Paper addressing the ways in which WCS licensees can make their systems immune to potential interference from DARS repeaters without significantly increasing the cost of WCS deployment.<sup>1</sup> Attending on behalf of XM were Phil Barsky, Derek de Bastos, and Lon Levin, along with XM Radio's counsel, Bruce Jacobs and David Konczal of Shaw Pittman LLP. Paul Marko and Craig Wadin of XM participated in the meeting via telephone.
