

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 262C1 at Crane, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 262C1 to Crane, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM station. Crane is an incorporated city with a population of 3,408 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Crane has its own mayor, Terry Schul, its own post office, its own fire department and its own city hall and its own independent school system.


