

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Katherine Pyeatt respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 272A at Sonora, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 272A to Sonora, Texas, as that community's first commercial FM service.

Sonora is the County Seat of Sutton County. An incorporated city with a Mayor and City Council, Sonora had a 1990 Census population of 2,983 persons. Five years later, its population had grown approximately 8 percent to 2,983 according to the Texas State Data Center, estimate as of January 1, 1996.

Sonora has its own independent school district, its own fire department, its own City Hall, its own post office and its own Chamber of Commerce. Sutton County has its courthouse and sheriff's office in Sonora.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 272A can be allocated to Sonora, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. See revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992).


