

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 256A at McGregor, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 256A to McGregor, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. McGregor is an incorporated city with a population of 4,834 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. McGregor has its own mayor, Jimmy Herring, its own post office, its own school system, its own fire department and its own city hall.

Attached hereto is a channel study confirming that Channel 256A can be allocated to McGregor, Texas consistent with the FCC's FM separation rules. 
