

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 255A at Floydada, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 255A to Floydada, Texas, as that community's first competing commercial FM service. Floydada is an incorporated city and the county seat of Floyd County. Floydada has a population of 3,759 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Floydada has its own mayor, Bobby Gillian, its own post office, its own school system, its own county court house, its own city hall, its own fire department and a number of local churches.


