

PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 284C at Channing, Texas.

DISCUSSION

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 284C to Channing, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Channing is an incorporated city and the county seat of Hartley County. Channing has a population of 285 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Channing has its own mayor, Leslie Kistner, its own post office, its own school system, its own county court house and a number of local churches.


