

**PETITION FOR RULE MAKING**

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 1.401, Linda Crawford respectfully petitions the FCC to institute a Rule Making proceeding to amend the FM Table of Allotments to add Channel 271C3 at Lockney, Texas.

**DISCUSSION**

Petitioner respectfully submits that the public interest would be served by allocating Channel 271C3 to Lockney, Texas, as that community's first aural broadcast transmission service. Lockney is an incorporated city with a population of 2,048 people as of January 1, 1998 according to the Texas State Data Center. Lockney has its own mayor, Gary Marr, its own school system, its own post office, its own fire department, its own city hall and a number of local churches.
